

Oklahoma Leather Association Power Exchange Contest

All contestants must read and understand the qualifications for being a contestant.

The following are the rules for qualification and what is expected of the contestants

- 1. You must be at least twenty-one years old.
- 2. You must be available for March 7th Social and March 8th contest.
- 3. This contest is open to any pair/poly/triad that's in a "power exchange" relationship for at least one year.
- 4. You must complete your required paperwork as outlined in the "Contestant Checklist" by the deadline
- 5. You must be able to communicate and teach others about your specific power exchange dynamic.
- 6. You are not permitted to be under the influence of illegal drugs or an excessive amount of alcohol during any of the contest portions.
- 7. You cannot have a current title that conflicts with the Scissortail PE contest or with the rules of your current title. If you hold a current title, contact the Scissortail PE contest director immediately to find out if you are still eligible to compete in the Scissortail PE contest.
- 8. You must agree to be photographed and allow the photographs to be used on the Scissortail Leather Contest

- and Midwest Power Exchange website and social media. If not possible, state the reasons why in your application.
- 9. You will be expected to always wear contestant numbers until the end of the contest. These will be provided at the contestant meeting before the Meet and Greet.
- 10. You must not have any outstanding warrants either nationally or internationally and you must not be currently under indictment in any court of law.
- 11. If you win, you will agree to present at least 4 (four) workshops, classes, or demos to teach others about your specific dynamic at 4 (four) different national events during your title year.
- 12. If you win, you will agree to return to the Oklahoma Leather Association Scissortail Power Exchange Contest the following year to welcome/stepdown to the next contestants.
